BRIEF DESCRIPTION OF EVENTS

South West Centre Championship—All SW centre members get **free** entry in the South West Drivers Championship, see our website for details.

Autotest*— A timed event that consists of a number of routes around bollards. Can be run on tarmac or grass.

Autosolo*— Similar to an Autotest but all forwards around numbered cones. Competitors split into 3 groups, competing, marshals and preparation. Once all competitors have their runs the groups swap, competitors become marshals, marshals become prep and prep group then compete.

Kimber Classic Trial*— A number of “gentle”, up hill, slippery sections, including a ford, linked by road sections.

Car Trial*—Several muddy, slippery uphill “sections” on one site. The further up each section you get the better. Gets your car muddy but tremendous fun. Passengers are mandatory.

Social Run/Touring Assembly—Often from/to a place of interest down ‘B’ and ‘White’ roads that you never knew were there. Time to look around, have lunch and a chat then home again.

Sprint—On tarmac timed to 1/100th of a second, very fast. MSA licences, crash helmets and fireproof overalls required.

Wiscombe Hill Climb—An uphill sprint! A stunningly beautiful venue, excellent spectator sport with a wide variety of cars entering. MSA licences, crash helmets and fireproof overalls required.
