



SUPPLEMENTARY REGULATIONS

1. The MG Car Club Limited - Midland Centre, will organise a Clubman status Navigational Regularity Rally on Sunday 17 October 2021. The event will be held under the General Regulations of the Motor Sport UK Ltd (incorporating the provisions of the International Sporting Code of the FIA), www.motorsportuk.org yearbook, these Supplementary Regulations and any Instructions issued for the event.
2. A MSUK Permit has been applied for, and route liaison work carried out.
The running of this event will incorporate the guidelines and procedures provided by Motorsport UK for compliance with appropriate Covid-19 safety requirements. To this end all pre-event paperwork will be issued by e-mail. Social Distancing and wearing of face masks will be monitored by the Covid Compliance Officer.
3. The event will be a round of the 2021 Inter Register Club Championship is open pre-1963 cars entered by fully elected members of clubs comprising the Inter Register Club as listed below, and also to MGCC members in any age MG.

All competitors (driver and all passengers) must hold a MotorsportUK RS Clubman Licence which is free and can be applied for on-line at <https://rsclubman.motorsportuk.org/> if you hold a UK Passport. Sight of Club Membership Cards and Licences may be requested upon arrival.

4. The event will be run using the 1:50,000 series Ordnance Survey Landranger maps, 149 - Hereford & Leominster and 162 - Gloucester and Forest of Dean. A Romer, for plotting grid references onto the map is recommended. A Speed Table sheet will be issued by the organiser.
Satnavs or Global Positioning Systems are not allowed and the penalty for their use is disqualification. Electronic distance recorders are permitted.
5. The rally will start and finish at Westons Cider Mill, Much Marcle at Map Ref:149 / 649330. Arrival procedures will take place between 10:30am and 11:15am, and any competitor not parked up by 11.30 may be deemed a non-starter. Roadbooks will be issued at arrival by collection. Cars will leave at one minute intervals from 11:30am. Trailers and support vehicles may be left at this venue.
6. The route will cover 60 to 65 miles on smooth tarmac. The route will include Regularity Sections timed to the second at secret time controls. White roads will not be used.

The route will be defined by a variety of straightforward navigation methods (request additional notes if required). Timing details (see additional notes) and penalties will be incurred for every second early or late at the Time Controls. The maximum time penalty at any Time Control will be 5 minutes.

Penalty for early or late arrival at a Time Control: 1 second per second.

Penalty for failing to visit a Time Control will be 10 minutes

Penalty for failing to record a Passage Control Codeboard will be 5 minutes.

7. This is a driving competition on the public highway in a rural area where the roads are often narrow and likely to include horse traffic. All entrants must be courteous to all other road users and driving at excessive speed will be treated as a danger to others and likely to bring our sport into disrepute.

Any complaint from a member of the public or exuberant driving observed by an official of the event will result in a 10 minute penalty or Disqualification at the organiser's discretion.

Competitors must stop at all standing Give Way or Stop signs and at any other junctions notified as Give Way in the Roadbook. Failure to comply will incur a penalty of 5 minutes for first offence and Disqualification for second offence.

8. All entrants' cars must be road legal – properly taxed for road use with adequate Road Traffic Act insurance. **As there will be no detail scrutineering, every driver must sign the organisers' document stating that his vehicle is in good working order and safe to use on the public highway. The event Scrutineer has authority to decline a start if he deems the condition of any competing vehicle to be unsatisfactory – the Scrutineer's decision is final and not subject to protest.**

As there are Time Controls on this event standard insurance policies may not be adequate.

If the entrant does not have an extension to his existing policy for participating in a timed 12-car rally, the organisers can arrange cover for the day at a cost of £20 providing the driver complies with the following:

- Age 19 years and above
- Held a driving licence for a minimum of six months
- Has no more than 6 penalty points on his licence
- Has had no more than one fault claim in the preceding 3 years.

9. Classes will be as follows:

Class A	Pre 1963 Vehicle Expert
Class B	Pre 1963 Vehicle Novice
Class C	MGCC member in post 1963 vehicle.

A Novice crew is one in which no member has won a 1st, 2nd or 3rd Class award in any navigational event during the previous three years.

The organisers reserve the right to amalgamate classes if necessary.

No penalty will be incurred for carrying additional passengers, but driver and navigator must be nominated on the Entry Form and all occupants must hold a Motorsport UK RS Clubman Licence.

Final Instructions will be e-mailed to competitors on 11 October 2021 and will include competition numbers, advance route information, procedures for the start venue and a list of entrants.

Competitors will also receive e-mailed declaration forms which will include a self scrutineering statement, a covid 19 health statement, and names and addresses of all passengers to be carried in the vehicle.

These documents must be signed and e-mailed back to the Clerk of the Course before 17.00 on Friday 15 October 2021, including any details not included or alterations from those submitted on the Entry Form.

10. Results will be e-mailed as soon as possible after the event.
Awards (for both nominated crew members) will be as follows:-

First in Class A and Class B.
Best performance in an MG (MGCC Members only)
Crews can win only one of the above awards.

12. The entry fee of £25 per car must be enclosed with the entry form. The maximum number of entrants is 12 and the minimum is 6, minimum per class is 3.
