REGULATIONS

1. The MG Car Club Ltd Midland Centre and in association with MGCC Southwest Centre will promote a non-competitive Social Road Run. A 25 mile scenic route from the **M4 Severn View Services** or from **Starbucks Ross-on-Wye** to the **Hopewell Colliery** on Sunday 21 April 2024.
2. The event is open to members of the MG Car Club Ltd, MG Owners Club and other classic car owners.
3. The event will be held under the General Regulations of Motorsport UK Ltd (incorporating the provisions of the International Sporting code of the FIA), which can be viewed on the MotorsportUK.org website; these Supplementary Regulations and any written instructions the promoting club may issue for the event.
4. As a non-competitive event, MSUK competition licences are not required. Motorsport UK Ltd Exemption Certificate Permit is not deemed necessary.
5. The tour will be approximately 25 miles in length from either start to the finish at the **Hopewell Colliery**. There is a café at the finish or bring your own picnic. Optional **Sunday Roast** is available if pre-booked: £14 or £17.50 two course. Tel. Kay 01594810706
6. All drivers must have a current valid driving licence for driving in the UK. All cars must be road legal and insured as required under the Road Traffic Act. You should check with your insurer that you are covered for an untimed touring event.
 - Signing-on will be by e-mail or at Documentation at each start venue from 10.30 am until 11.00, where you will be provided with your Road Book if you have not downloaded a copy with your Final Instructions. (No complex navigation skills are necessary), The tour will start with the cars departing from 11.01 am.
7. The route will be given in an easy-to-follow Road Book with some Tulip Diagrams. Maps are not necessary to complete the route, but Ordnance Survey 'Landranger' map 1:50,000 scale, map number 162 has been used to determine the route.
8. Entries open on the publication of these Regulations, and close for a FREE entry at 5.00 pm on 18 April 2024. All entries must be made on the official entry form. Late entries received after 18 April £5 must be paid for at the Start Venue Documentation.
9. The minimum number of cars entered from each start venue is 6, and the maximum is 15. Should the minimum number not be reached the organisers reserve the right to cancel the event. Late entries on the day may be possible (£5 entry fee) if the maximum has not been reached and subject to any Covid Regulations.
10. Drivers Briefing / Final Instructions will be made by email on 18 April 2024 with a copy of the Roadbook that you should download and print. You MUST Sign On by replying to the Final Instructions by e-mail, which is necessary to invoke MGCC Ltd insurance cover for the event organisation.

11. Change of car is permitted provided you notify the Organisers on the day of the event at the Documentation start venue.
12. The timetable of the event will be as follows:
 - Final Documentation at each Start Venue will be from 10.30 until 11.00.
 - The first car to leave the start will be at 11.01.
 - Arrival time at the finish is anticipated between 12.00 and 13.00 dependant if you stop for coffee or lunch with friends on route.
 - Tour through the **Hopewell Colliery** is not included with your entry. You have to pre-book a tour through the museum website; www.hopewellcolliery.com The cost is £10 per person and a guided tour takes about 60 minutes. Stout footwear and a warm jumper recommended -10° C underground.
13. There may be no petrol filling stations on the route, except at each start venue.
